

Four Lakes Yacht Club Clubhouse Guidelines

The Clubhouse is for all members. It is our intent to make all of our facilities available to the General membership with minimal disruption. If having other club members present would bother your occasion, please schedule it elsewhere.

The board will look at approving party requests during boats in / out season only during the week (Mon-Thurs) effective April 11, 2022.

There is a \$100.00 fee for parties. \$50.00 fee will be used to fund replacement due to wear and tear and \$50.00 will be refunded if the clubhouse is left clean and in good shape.

Cleanup must be completed immediately following the event. Cleaning should include vacuuming/mopping of floor, removal of garbage and recyclable that you generate, wiping down of surfaces, etc. The expectation is the facility will be left in the same condition as it was found.

We are all responsible for the security of the Club Facilities and Grounds. If you're the last one to leave the Clubhouse activate the Clubhouse security prior to leaving.

Four Lakes Yacht Club is a smoke – free facility. Smoking is not permitted inside the Clubhouse or in any of the storage buildings.

The sale of alcoholic beverages is not permitted in Four Lakes Yacht Club facilities or on the properties. The Four Lakes Yacht Club does not hold a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Guests are not allowed on other Members boats or piers without invitation.

Respect our Tenant and Neighbors. Do not exceed a reasonable noise level.

Do not allow usage of the emergency crash bar on the gate between the Breakwater and our Facilities. This is intended for the Breakwater emergency fire exit only.

If you turned it on----you turn it off. We have power bills just as you do. Bathroom heaters as well as some other devices pose potential safety issues if they are left on and unattended.

You are responsible for your guests.
