Four Lakes Yacht Club Membership Code of Conduct

Approved, Board of Directors on February 8, 2021

Purpose

Membership with Four Lakes Yacht Club is a privilege and with that privilege come certain responsibilities. The Member Code of Conduct outlines the expectations of FLYC members to ensure that FLYC members and guests enjoy the facilities in a safe and respectful manner.

General Principles

Members and guests will show courtesy and respect to others. Members and guests will observe all rules and regulations established by the club.

Illegal conduct and sexual harassment of any kind is strictly prohibited while on club property, including leased storage spaces and slips, and while attending any club sponsored events. Sexual harassment includes unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical harassment of a sexual nature. Violations of this rule may be turned over to law enforcement and may result in suspension or termination of membership, as determined by the board of directors. Any member who observes illegal, dangerous, or inappropriate conduct should immediately notify a member of the club's board. All such reports shall remain confidential.

Guidelines

Safety First - Be mindful of individual safety and the safety of others involved on Club premises and/ or during Club activities.

Respect Always - Show respect, civility, and consideration towards other Club members, guests, staff, and Club property.

Honesty and Integrity- All members must ensure that they, their guests, and children abide by the Club rules and this Member Code of Conduct.

No FLYC member shall be given or expect preferential treatment, including Board of Directors, and/or volunteers.

Appropriate Behavior

Respect, dignity and proper regard to all members rights and obligations.

Respect for the privacy of others.

Fair, considerate, and honest treatment of others.

Mature and acceptable social behavior while at the club.

Mindful behavior of individual safety and the safety of all others.

Responsibility that all guests abide by the Club's Member Code of Conduct.

Youth Protection

Parents or parent's substitutes shall be responsible for the conduct of persons in their care under the age of 22 years of age. Members, office holders, and volunteers who instruct and/or assist children in any Club endorsed activity must adhere to this standard.

Compliance

Violations of the Member Code of Conduct will be referred to the Board of Directors for review and resolution. Should the offending member's conduct be found to be improper or injurious to the interest or good order of the club, they may be subject to section 4.4 of the Club by-laws (termination / expulsion).

Reporting Violations

Reports will be taken from any member of the club and all information will be kept strictly confidential. All reports of suspected violations will be thoroughly investigated, and you will receive a response if possible and appropriate. There will be no reprisals against any member reporting a violation or suspected violation in good faith.
